LOWER BODY REQUIREMENTS

OTHER REQUIREMENTS & SPECIAL DAYS

<p>ACCESSORIES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No hats, hoods or sunglasses worn inside school buildings on regular school days. Closed toe shoes or boots. No sandals, flip flops, wheelies, or heels over 2". Crocs are acceptable. No color requirements. <p>PE CLASS LPCA T-shirt with Navy PE Shorts – purchased specifically from LPCA for PE class. Students must return to uniform dress prior to leaving PE class. Students may wear navy or black athletic sweatpants for class only when the weather is cooler.
